Proceedings: Plaintiff’s motion for relief from judgment or order [10] (“Motion”)

Rulings: The Motion is DENIED.

Discussion:

The Motion fails to set forth any basis for granting Plaintiff relief from the Court’s 07/22/11 Order denying Plaintiff leave to proceed in forma pauperis [2]. Moreover, the Court also takes judicial notice that, on October 18, 2011, the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit filed its Order [5] that disallowed Plaintiff’s appeal of this Court’s 07/22/11 Order from proceeding “[b]ecause the appeal is so insubstantial as to not warrant further review.” Plaintiff’s pending Motion, like his appeal, raises similar arguments that are equally insubstantial or frivolous.
